# **Our Mission**


To provide a safe and caring environment that empowers students to exhibit the determination and resiliency to meet high-quality and relevant curriculum challenges.

# THERE ARE 5 SCHOOLS THAT MAKE UP MCPSD#1

Badlands Elementary (K-5), Fox Hills Elementary (K-5), Watford City Middle School (6-8), Watford City High School (9-12) and Wolves Center Academy (9-12 alternative school).

A \$35 million dollar Elementary School, Fox Hills, opened in Fall of 2020 and a \$53 million dollar High School with an attached events center opened in 2016.

MCPSD#1 has started constructing a \$20 million dollar Bakken Area Skills Center which will enhance the already deep bonds between the school system and our industry partners. It will not only serve the school but the community as a whole and will help "upskill" the local workforce to meet industry needs.

# NUMBER OF TEACHERS

There are 157 teachers in McKenzie County Public School District #1.

### **TECHNOLOGY**

All teachers are equipped with an Apple MacBook Air laptop and iPad. All classrooms have brand new BenQ boards, Document Cameras and Audio Enhancement Systems. Device per student ratio is 1:1 for all students district wide.

# AREA EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES




- Join Western North Dakota every August in Downtown Watford City for Ribfest! An event filled with entertainment for the whole family.

Watford City has seen its population grow due to the North Dakota oil boom, and the town has focused on creating the infrastructure to accommodate the increasing number of people moving to the area for work, while also touting local attractions to appeal to people unrelated to the energy industry, like nearby Theodore Roosevelt National Park. Its population has declined slightly after a reported peak in 2019 of 7,817 residents, but Watford City's growth since 2010 is still significant.
